#### TIE-BREAKER RULES SUMMARY (See RULEBOOK for complete rules):

1. If two teams are tied with the best won-lost record, the winner of the pool game between the two tied teams will be the tie-breaker and that team will advance to the next segment. If the teams did not play each other, see rule 2 below.
2. If two teams are tied with the best won-lost record, and they did not play each other, then the **"Runs-Allowed Ratio"** will be computed to break the tie. The team with the lowest **"Runs-Allowed Ratio"** per game played will advance.
3. If three teams or more are tied with the same won-lost record, and one team has defeated the other tied teams, then that team will advance to the next segment. If one of the remaining tied teams is to advance, use Rule 1 above.
4. If three or more teams are tied with the same won-lost record, and one team has not defeated the other tied teams, then the **"Runs-Allowed Ratio"** will be computed to break the tie. The team with the lowest **"Runs-Allowed Ratio"** per game will advance. If one or more of the remaining tied teams is to advance, use the **"Runs-Allowed Ratio"** per game.

# TOURNAMENT RULES

1. No practice is allowed on the tournament field. Alternate fields are available.
2. Only players, the manager, and (1 or 2 coaches) shall occupy the dugout during the game. Scorekeepers are not allowed in the dugout unless they are an approved coach.
3. **Intentional throwing of bats, helmets, or other items, use of profanity, or other Unsportsmanlike actions will not be tolerated. Such action may result in ejection.**
4. Have players hustling at all times to prevent unnecessary delays.
5. The tournament umpiring staff will be all volunteers. We will not tolerate any harassment or condemnation of them. Your questions or discussion with umpires must be done in a calm and gentlemanly manner at all times.
6. All protests regarding book rules must be presented immediately to the plate umpire. The umpire allows no protests on judgment calls.  
**PROTESTS MUST BE RESOLVED BEFORE THE NEXT PITCH.**
7. The official scorekeeper will be in the press box and announce each batter in the proper batting order. Be sure to notify the home plate umpire and official scorekeeper of any changes in the line-up. Failure to do so will only delay the game.
8. The scoreboard is for the convenience of the spectators and shall not be considered official. The plate umpire is the official regarding balls, strikes, and outs.
9. A coin flip that will decide who will be home team for all games (except for the championship segment) will be held at the Managers meeting. **The third base dugout is the home team.**
10. All managers and coaches are reminded that smoking, or tobacco is not allowed on the playing field or in the dugouts prior to, during, or after the game. You also cannot leave the dugout or the field area during the game for a smoke or chew.
11. No pins are to be worn on caps or uniforms during the game. All wristwatches, rings, bracelets, necklaces, or other jewelry is to be removed.
12. Managers and coaches can not warm up the pitcher prior to, or during the game, (this also includes in the bullpen). Players warming up a pitcher must wear a catcher's mask and helmet on the field, or in the bullpen.
13. **Pets, large coolers and cooking grills are not allowed in the park.**
14. **If you're batting helmets have any stickers or painting on them you will need a letter from the manufacture giving you permission.**

## **Home Run Derby Saturday Night**

When: Saturday July 13, 2019

Time: following the 3<sup>rd</sup> game and picnic

The home run derby will consist of 2 players from each team to hit, 1 player to catch, and 1 player or coach to throw pitches. Each player will receive 8 swings and will be scored accordingly.

Swing and miss = 0 pts

Foul ball = 0 pts

Infield hit = 2 pts

Outfield section 1 in the air = 4 pts

Outfield section 2 in the air = 6 pts

Home run over the fence = 12 pts

In the event of a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> place there will be a 5-swing hit off.
