1. Open ceremonies will be conducted at noon. We will bring the teams onto the field in alphabetical order. Managers, please provide us with a list of your district administrators name, league president, manager, coaches and players. If you have a district flag, please bring that as well.
2. Included is a pre-order shirt form GLL will be selling. The order form needs to be returned to me by July 3rd. I would also ask that your team designate one person to collect order, money, pay and pick up order. We will have orders separated and ready to go. We will take cash and checks(made out to GLL). If you do not pre-order we cannot guarantee a shirt.
3. We are also making a tournament program and will need a copy of your roster with the league name you are representing, players names, manager, coaches, league president and district administrator. Please remit this as soon as possible.

SENIOR BOYS BASEBALL INDIANA STATE TOURNAMENT

Congratulations to all for winning your district/section tournaments and advancing to this years state tournament!

RULES

1. Coin toss will determine home/visitors for each game. This will take place approximately 30 minutes before the start of the game.
2. Dugouts will be determined AFTER coin toss.
3. Greenwood Little League is a tobacco free facility. This includes vape pens.
4. Managers will need to turn in any and all paperwork(proof of eligibility)and affidavits at the managers meeting. It will be returned to you at the end of the tournament or as your team is eliminated. Please make sure to go to the district table at the end of each game to sign said affidavit.
5. Managers are to report all changes to the tower.
6. **NO ONE** is allowed to leave the dugout during the game without the umpires permission. No coach/manager is allowed on the field without calling time first **AND** its granted.
7. Once the teams take the dugout only the managers and 2 coaches who are on the affidavit are permitted in the dugout. Exceptions will be made in the event of an injury.
8. No cell phone use unless ok'd by umpire before the start of the game for game changer purposes only.
9. Managers please re-iterate to fans, players, parents that all balls/strikes, outs/safes, fouls/fairs are judgement calls made by the umpires. These **ARE NOT** arguable. Managers/coaches you are responsible for your fans.
10. In the event of a protest, call time and notify the home plate umpire **BEFORE** the next pitch is thrown. District will become involved at this time.
11. Little League International rules will be followed at all times.
12. Managers/coaches must be in proper attire. No cut-offs/No flip flops.
13. Remember this is a kids games and about the kids! Have fun, have good sportsmanship and enjoy making memories.

OPENING CEREMONIES will start at Noon. We will have the teams line up on the visitors side down the right field line fence and enter the gate along that side of the diamond to be recognized. If you have a district flag, please bring with you at this time. Managers please present a legible roster with **BOTH** first and last names as well as the coaches and manager. Please also include your home league and the district you are representing. We want to be able to recognize everyone!

TIE-BREAKER RULES SUMMARY (See RULEBOOK for complete rules):

1. If two teams are tied with the best won-lost record, the winner of the pool game between the two tied teams will be the tie-breaker and that team will advance to the next segment. If the teams did not play each other, see rule 2 below.
2. If two teams are tied with the best won-lost record, and they did not play each other, then the "Runs-Allowed Ratio" will be computed to break the tie. The team with the lowest "Runs-Allowed Ratio" per game played will advance.
3. If three teams or more are tied with the same won-lost record, and one team has defeated the other tied teams, then that team will advance to the next segment. If one of the remaining tied teams is to advance, use Rule 1 above.
4. If three or more teams are tied with the same won-lost record, and one team has not defeated the other tied teams, then the "Runs-Allowed Ratio" will be computed to break the tie. The team with the lowest "Runs-Allowed Ratio" per game will advance. If one or more of the remaining tied teams is to advance, use the "Runs-Allowed Ratio" per game.
