

 - a. First and Last Names of Players, Manager, Coaches, League President and District Administrator (all must be LEGIBLY written)
 - b. Include Uniform Number of Each Player
 - c. Team Colors and League Location (Town/City)
- 2. Contact Information for *Managers and Coaches (*required for contact during tournament)
 - d. Cell Phone Number
 - e. Email Address
- 3. Photo of your Championship team (preferably with your banner)

Items of importance to produce

Make sure to bring your Team Affidavit/Eligibility documentation, proof of residency, boundary map and medical release forms. Please also provide any applicable IId or IVh forms, and any additional <u>Little</u> <u>League</u> provided waivers/documentation. Player eligibility WILL be confirmed prior to play.

It is customary to trade/exchange pins during the announcement of players before each game. Please try to bring an adequate number with you representing your league or District. Four teams, max potential 16 players & three Coaches, recommend 75-100 total pins (Umpires and Staff usually have pins to trade as well)

<u>Appropriate</u> attire for Managers/Coaches shall be long pants (<u>No</u> baseball pants) or shorts and shirts must have sleeves. Tee Shirts are permitted if they are TEAM associated and in good taste. <u>NO</u> shortshorts, cut off shorts or shirts, tank tops or sleeveless shirts. Open toe/heel shoes (sandals/flip flops/crocs) are <u>NOT</u> allowed. Spikes/Cleats are <u>NOT</u> to be worn by Managers/Coaches; will not be allowed on field.

Tournament rules & guidelines overview along with coin tosses will be discussed during the MANDATORY Manager, Coach and Umpire meeting to be held 8:00 AM July 13, Roselawn Little League Complex. The Manager or a Coach from each team must be in attendance.


