Please find and review the 2025 Senior State Tournament Pre-Order Form found at the end of this packet. Follow the instructions and submit your order by the June 28 deadline found on the form.

4. Affidavit and Supporting Documents

If possible, we would prefer to receive your affidavit and supporting documents before the rush of Opening Day. Your tournament affidavit and supporting documents (aka affidavit book or affidavit binder) will be thoroughly reviewed and must contain all the neatly organized documents that were in it when your District Administrator approved it. Hopefully all of your documents will be perfectly in order, but the few hours between your arrival at the ballpark and the start of games is not ample time to resolve issues if they are not. In recent years, teams have successfully submitted their affidavit and supporting information as scanned documents on Google Docs or by email. Please contact Tournament Director Jim Kemp – jkemp8312@comcast.net - (765) 717-2454 to make arrangements to submit your affidavit and supporting documents **before Friday July 27, 2025** if possible.

Important items to bring to New Castle

1. **District Championship Banner:** Your team will parade on field with it during the Opening Ceremony.
2. **Affidavit and Supporting Documents:** Even if you submit your affidavit and supporting documents early, the tournament director must sign your affidavit, and the pitch count log must be completed after every game. **VERY IMPORTANT! DO NOT FORGET THIS AT HOME!** At the latest, your affidavit book must be submitted to the Tournament Director upon your arrival at the ballpark on Opening Day. **If you forget this, someone will need to travel back home to get it!**
3. **Pin Trading:** Pin trading at tournaments is a Little League tradition. It is customary for Indiana State Tournament teams to exchange pins. Bring an adequate number of pins that represent your league or district. It is recommended that you bring 100-120 pins. Umpires, staff, and teams that you do not play will have pins to trade.
4. **Coach Attire:** Appropriate attire for Managers/Coaches shall be long pants (no baseball pants) or shorts, and shirts must have sleeves. Collared shirts are preferred, but tee shirts are permitted if they are team-associated and in good taste. NO short-shorts, cut-off shorts or cut-off shirts, tank tops, or sleeveless shirts. Open toe/heel shoes (sandals/flip flops/crocs) are NOT allowed. Spikes/Cleats are NOT to be worn by Managers/Coaches, and will not be allowed on field.

Photographers: The tournament has an official photographer, and teams are encouraged to purchase photos from this photographer, as proceeds from photo purchases help fund the tournament. Only the official tournament photographer is permitted inside the fence. If a team brings its own photographer or has press covering their team, they must receive approval from the tournament director before being given field access. Flash photography is dangerous to the players and is prohibited.

Game Changer and Live Streaming: If tournament games are available on Game Changer, access instructions will be announced at the ballpark and on Facebook before each game. We are going to try to stream games on Game Changer. If our effort to stream games fails, teams will be permitted to use their own streaming methods; however, streaming will only be permitted if all players, the manager, and coaches on both teams participating in a game have approved form release and waiver (model release).

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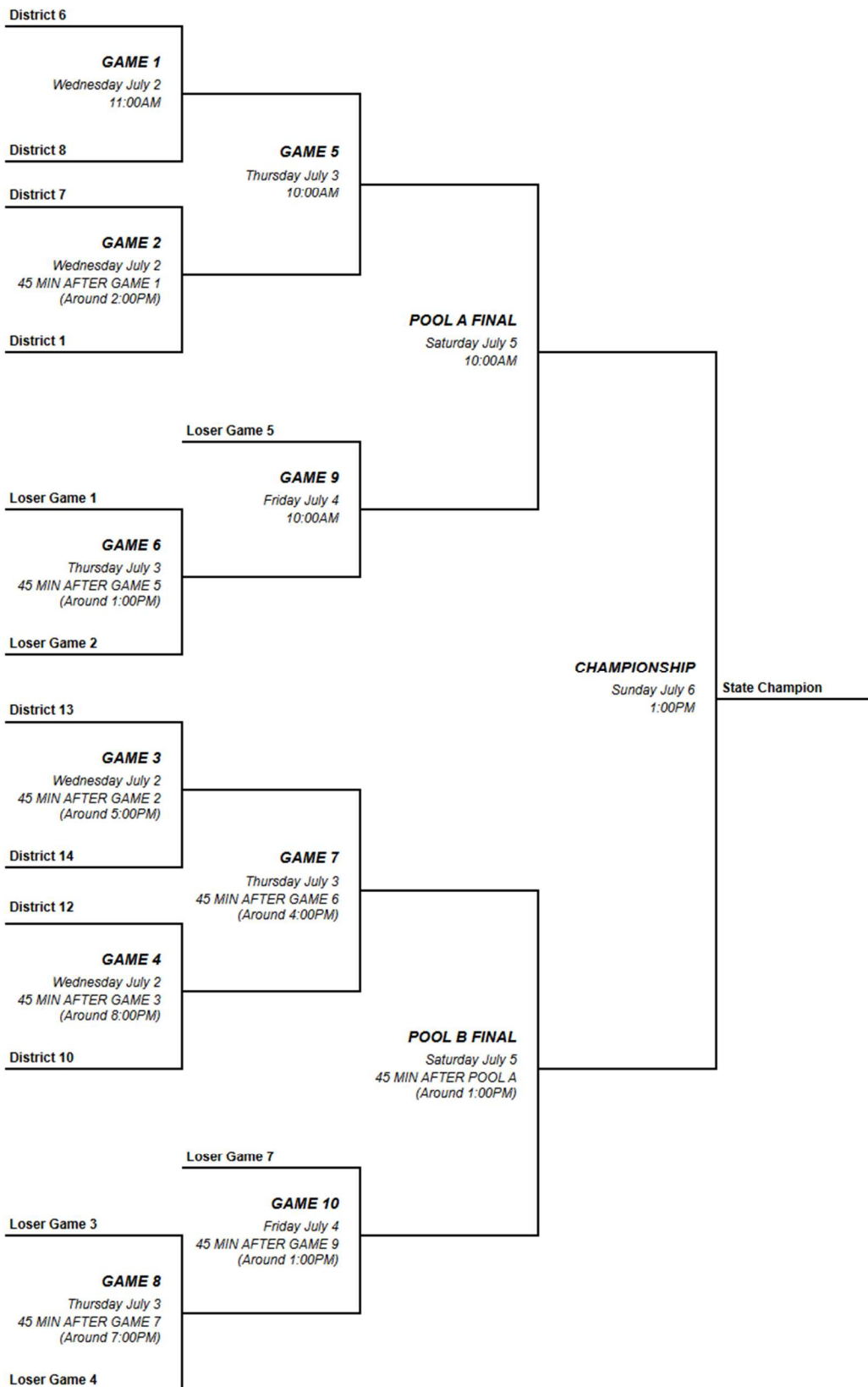

Primary Parking: The primary parking area for Denny Bolden Field is just east of the ballpark and marked with blue “P” on the map. Additional parking is also available at:

- New Castle Little League north of the ballpark.
- Baker Park south west of the ballpark.
- The Skate Park and Pool south of the ballpark.
- New Castle High School south west of the ballpark through Baker Park.

There may be other activities going on at these locations so please be patient as you attempt to park.



ADA Parking spots are reserved just to the south of the ballpark on M Avenue. There is also a gate where people can be dropped off on M Avenue just north of the ADA Parking spaces.

PRACTICE FACILITY

Collin MacAtee Memorial Field, the New Castle High School baseball diamond at Sunnyside Education Center will be the practice facility for the Senior League State Tournament.

Batting Cages

The batting cages at Denny Bolden Field will be reserved for the teams playing in games starting 90 minutes before their start time. Teams are welcomed to use the batting cages if they are unoccupied, but if a team preparing to start a game needs one, please vacate the cage and allow them access.



SENIOR LEAGUE STATE TOURNAMENT PARK RULES

The following items and activities are strictly prohibited at all Senior League Indiana State Tournament Venues:

- Pets of any kind (except certified service animals)
- Alcohol
- Illegal drugs
- Any kind of tobacco, vaping, or smoking products
- Weapons of any kind
- Skateboards, hover boards, rollerblades, scooters, and similar items
- Noisemakers (ex: vuvuzelas, thunder sticks, air horns, cow bells, gongs, drums, etc.)
- Fireworks
- Drones
- Soliciting
- Laser pointers
- Flash photography

Photographers: Only authorized photographers are permitted inside the fence, even in foul ball territory. Flash photography is dangerous to the players and is prohibited.

Scorers Tower Access: Spectators, including league presidents, are not permitted in the scoring tower, inside the dugout, or anywhere inside the fence unless invited by a tournament official. Managers and coaches are welcomed in the scoring tower as needed. Players may not be in the scoring tower.

Broadcasting / Online Streaming: Little League International holds the exclusive right to authorize all broadcasting and webcasting (live or recorded) of tournament games, even by fans. Any commercial broadcasting and/or webcasting of audio or video of the Indiana State Tournament, is prohibited unless contractually authorized by Little League International.

Non-commercial league- or parent-produced stream/webcasts will be permitted on a game-by-game basis with the approval of the tournament director. Little League has authorized this type of broadcast but only if all policies regarding commercialization and trademarks are followed **and that the appropriate releases (Form Release and Waiver/Media Release) from every player, coach, and umpire participating in the game have been received and approved.**

Tailgating: There is not room to allow tailgate parties in the parking lot so please ask your families not to do this.

Outside Food: New Castle Henry County Youth Baseball Little League respectfully requests that no outside food, drinks, coolers, or grills be brought to the tournament site except for team dugout refreshments. There are concessions on site for your convenience. Proceeds from concessions help offset tournament expenses.

Pop-Up Chairs and Tents are encouraged, as there is limited bleacher seating at the ballpark. Be considerate of fellow spectators. You will be asked to take down your tent if it obstructs the view of other spectators or if you set up in a no spectator area.

No Spectator Areas: Spectators will not be permitted directly next to either dugout or in the “Batter’s Eye” area of Center Field. Please be respectful of these areas, and do not force us to ask you to move.

Sportsmanship: Little League International and all of its local leagues promote and expect good sportsmanship by its players, coaches, volunteers, and spectators. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants and officials in a positive manner. Profanity, disparaging comments of any kind, or other intimidating actions taken by spectators, players, coaches, or volunteers will not be tolerated and are grounds for removal from the complex, with the assistance of local police if necessary. Such behavior may also jeopardize the eligibility of the participating teams within the Little League International Tournament. Please remember, Little League is about creating the best experience for the kids, and it’s on all of us to make that happen.

Cell phones are everywhere, and if you get out of control, someone may be taking a video of it. Do not embarrass yourself, your kids, your league, your district, and your community by being another example on social media of a youth league parent who cannot control their emotions.

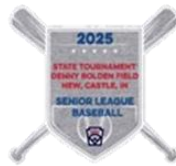

These kids want to carry on the kindness without judgement. They want to carry on the heart, that Jaxson had.

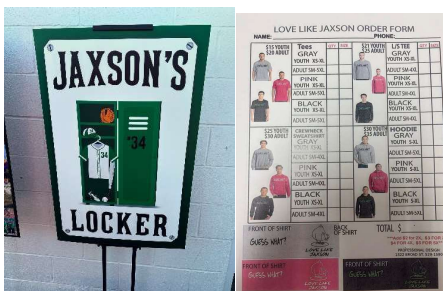
