There will be a mandatory manager/coach & umpire meeting on Friday, 7/17/2026, at **10:00** A.M. at Northcrest Little League under the tent. A manager or coach from each team and umpires are **REQUIRED** to attend and participate. **AT THIS MEETING**, Tournament rules & guidelines overview along with the first coin toss will be discussed during the **MANDATORY** Manager or Coach and Umpires meeting.

ITEMS OF IMPORTANCE TO PRODUCE AT MANAGER'S MEETING

Make sure to bring your Team Affidavit/Eligibility documentation, proof of residency, boundary map and medical release forms. Please also provide any applicable Ild or IVh forms, any additional Little League provided waivers/documentation. Player eligibility WILL be confirmed prior to play.

It is customary to trade/exchange pins during the announcement of players before each game. Please try to bring an adequate number with you representing your League or District. Eight teams, max potential 14 players & three Coaches, recommend 70-90 total pins. *Note:* Umpires and Staff often have pins to trade as well.

Appropriate attire for the Managers/Coaches shall be business casual attire, dress shorts or pants, shirts with sleeves or a Tee Shirt if they are Team associated and in good taste. NO short-shorts, cut-off shorts, tank tops or sleeveless shirts are allowed. Open toe/heel shoes (sandals/flip flops/crocs are also NOT allowed. Cleats are NOT to be worn by the Managers/Coaches.

Opening ceremonies will be on Friday, 7/17/2026, at approximately 11:30 A.M. (Before the games on Friday, each player will receive their state participation pin during the ceremony. Opening ceremonies are mandatory and more information will be given at the manager/coach meeting. **PLEASE BRING YOUR DISTRICT FLAG FOR OPENING CEREMONIES.**

The park is open at first light and the Diamonds will be open, at 8:00 am.

Please take special notice that we will be offering souvenir t-shirts on a **PRE-ORDER basis ONLY**. This applies to the teams and the parents of those teams. There are instructions included in this packet. The shirt orders are on a deadline – they MUST be ordered by 12:00PM EST (Noon) on 7/11/2026 since they take several days to be printed and delivered. We want to have them available for pick-up at the Manager/Coaches meeting on Friday, 7/17/2026.

There will be NO alcoholic beverages allowed on the grounds. Pets are allowed on the grounds with a leash and doggie bags to clean up after them. Service Dogs are also allowed. There will be NO use of tobacco products (smoking, vaping or chewing) by the players, managers, coaches and guests once you arrive at the School grounds for your games. 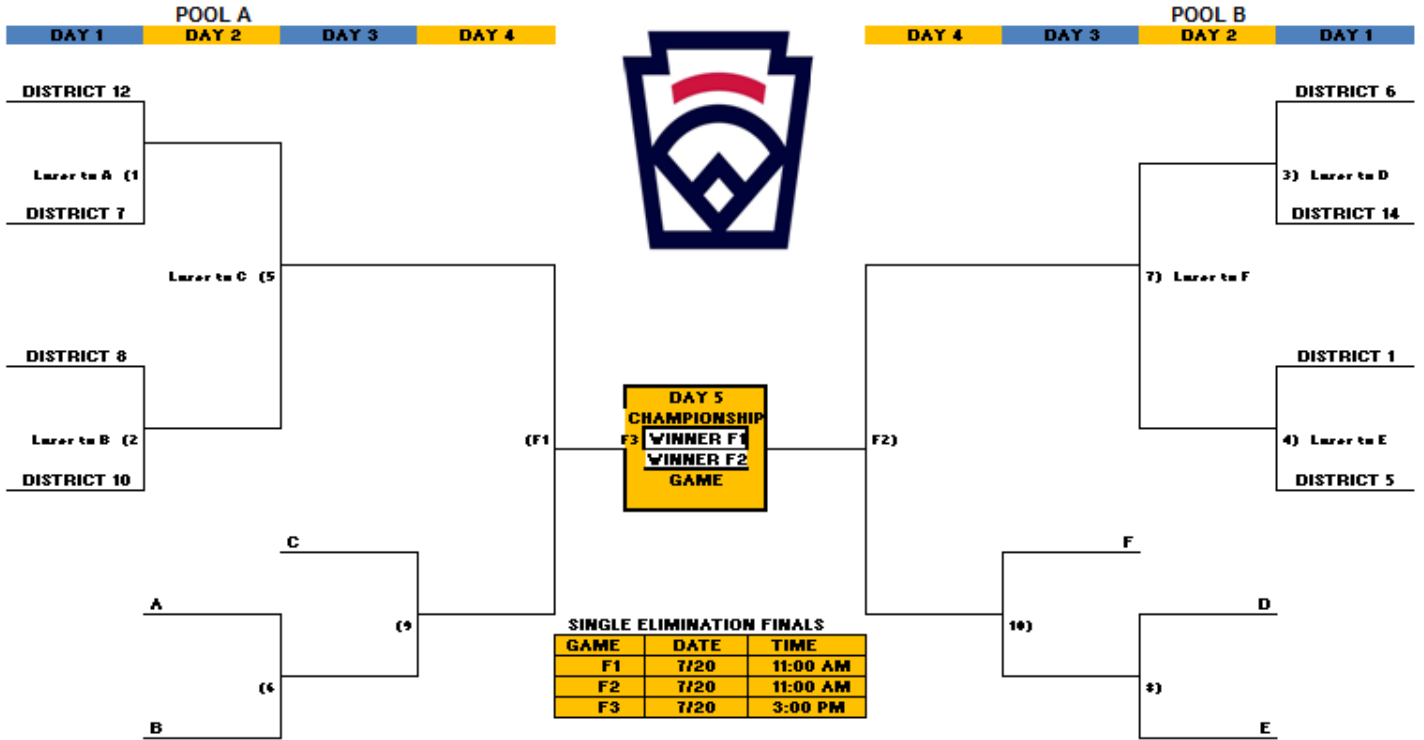

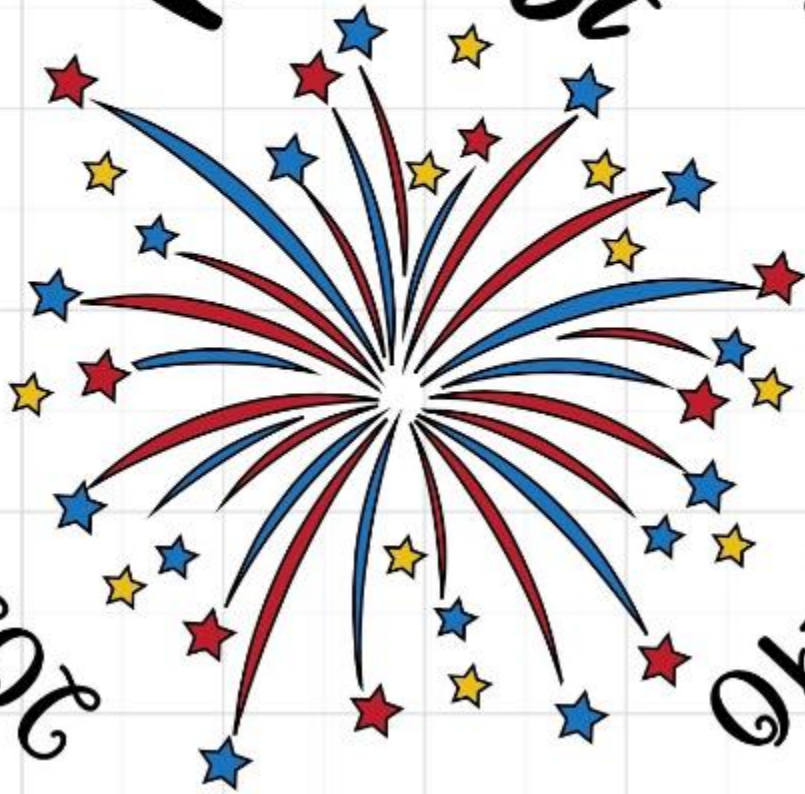
