We ask that you please respect the property at the ballpark as you would your home parks.

The following information will be required to produce at tournament site:

During the pre-tournament briefing on Friday, July 10th, each team must produce their team binder that includes their team affidavit, proof of residency (three forms, school enrollment form, or regulation II), and their affidavit map. Please make sure any and all waiver documentations is included in your team binder. Team binders will be checked and returned to your team by the end of day on Friday.

It is customary to exchange pins during the tournament with players of the other team before each game. Please try to bring an adequate number of pins with you. There are three other teams, maximum of 14 players per team, equals approximately 50 pins. Please be sure to bring your district tournament championship banner for the Opening Ceremony.

Appropriate attire for the team manager and coaches will be long pants or shorts with shirts with sleeves. Tee shirts will only be permitted if they are team associated. No short-shorts, no cut off shorts or shirts, and no tank tops will be permitted. Open toe/heel shoes (sandals, flip flops, crocs) will not be permitted. Managers and coaches are not permitted to wear baseball uniforms attire, which includes no spikes/cleats.

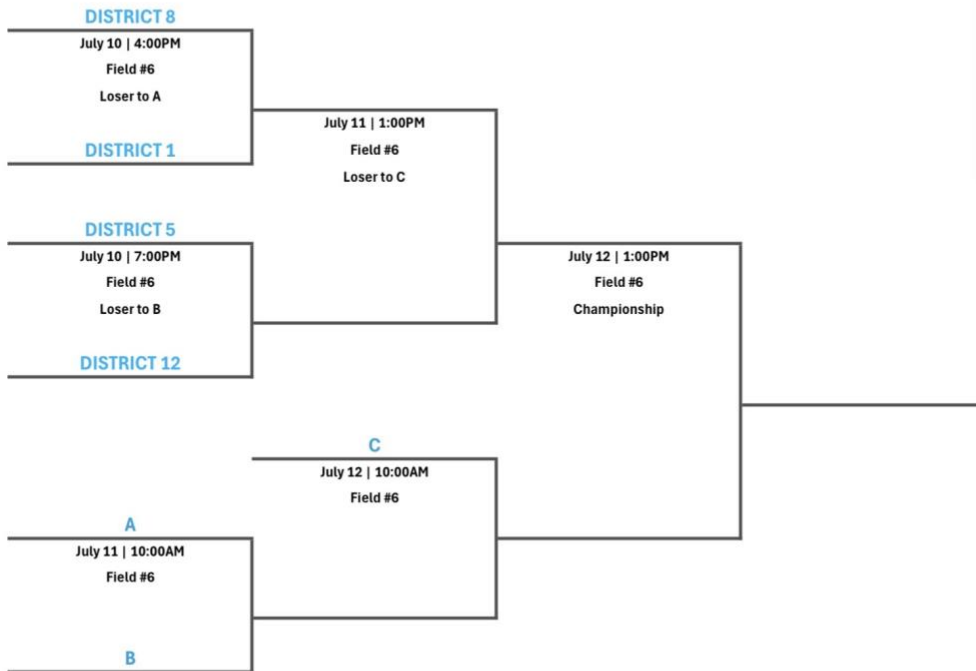

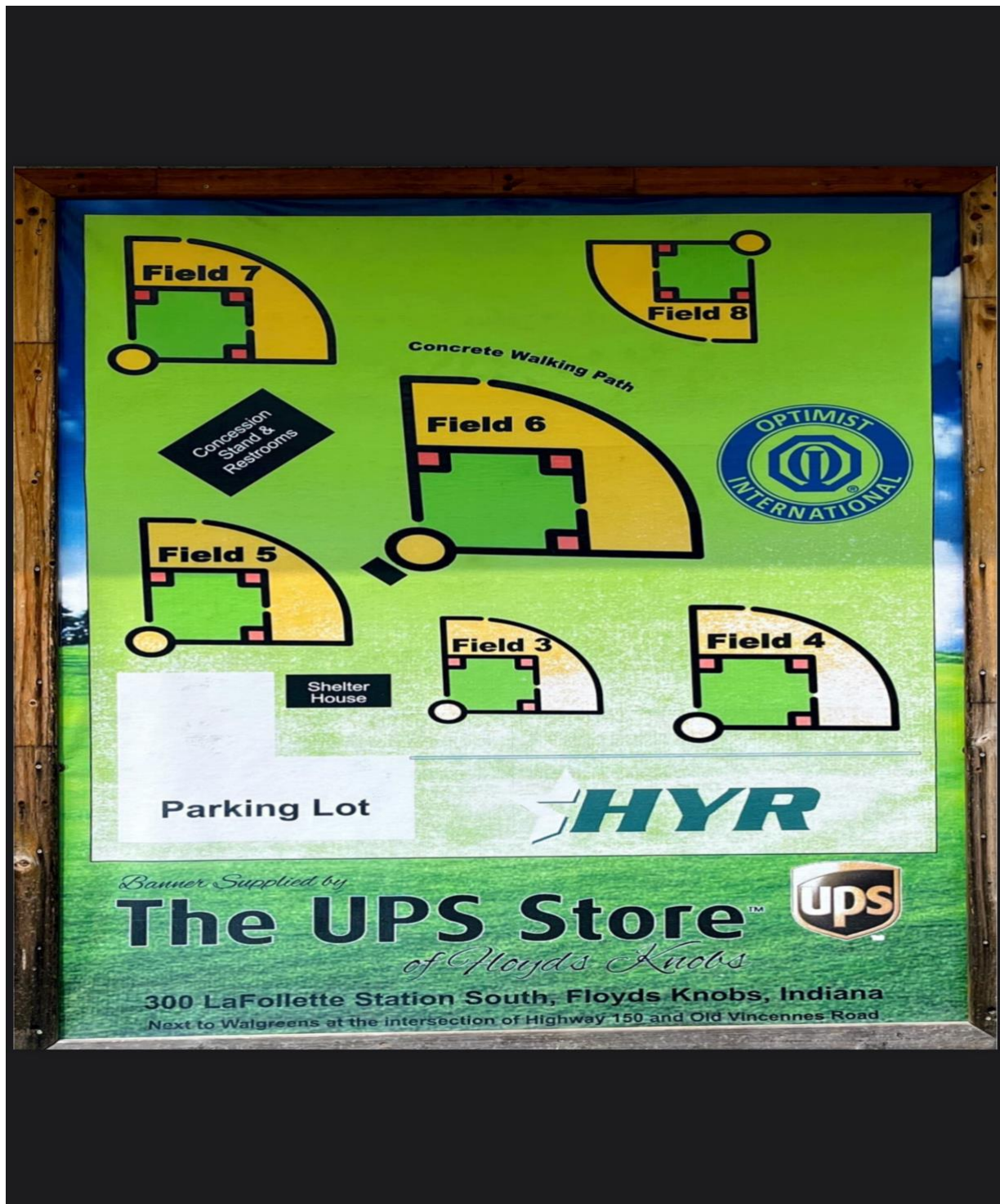
